**BACKGROUND:**

The Eastern Cape Office of the Premier (ECOTP) is currently implementing a small town revitalization programme at Amahlathi Local Municipality, the purpose of which is to accelerate the delivery of basic infrastructure services, strengthen planning, delivery and maintenance of infrastructure through institutional capacity building.

**PROCESS**

The successful students will be ranked on academic excellence and placed by the municipality with Civil and Electrical Engineering Consulting and construction firms contracted on the Small Town Revitalisation programme for a period not exceeding 12 months. Interested students are requested to submit applications accordingly. The stipend is R9 000 a month inclusive of site allowance and travel.

**Before applying, please ensure that you meet ALL the following minimum entry criteria - failure to satisfy all the requirements will result in your application being disqualified:**

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY:**

- Certified copy of Identification document;
- Certified copy of Technikon/University Academic results;
- Certified copy of a letter stating eligibility for experiential training (P1/P2) from your institution of higher learning;
- Applicants should obtain a letter confirming their proof of residence from their respective Ward Councillors of Amahlathi Municipality;
- Students must have completed their theoretical studies and be available to attend a compulsory interview on the date that will be confirmed after a positive outcome of pre-assessments.


**MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR FIELD OF STUDY NEEDED TO APPLY:**

- Must be studying / studied towards a Civil Engineering or Electrical Engineering qualification (proof of registration for those still studying must be attached).
- Must be seeking in-service training (work integrated learning for P1 and P2) to attain a National Diploma in Electrical or Civil Engineering.
- Must be studying / studied at a University of Technology in South Africa.

Please note that **ONLY** Students who are from the Amahlathi Locality will be considered as part of capacity and youth employment under this programme.
