BACKGROUND:

The Eastern Cape Office of the Premier (ECOTP) is currently implementing a Small-Town Revitalization (STR) programme at Amahlathi Local Municipality, the purpose of which is to accelerate the delivery of basic infrastructure through institutional capacity building.

PROCESS

The successful students will be ranked on academic excellence and placed by the municipality with Civil and Electrical Engineering Consulting and construction firm contracted on the Small-Town Revitalisation programme for a period not exceeding 6 months. Interested students are requested to submit applications accordingly. The stipend is R 9 000 a month inclusive of site allowance and travel.

NB: The successful candidates will be work on site.

Before applying, please ensure that you meet ALL the following minimum entry criteria – failure to satisfy all the requirements will result in your application being disqualified:


MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet all the following criteria. Failure to comply will result in disqualification:

- Certified copy of a valid South African Identity Document
- Certified copy of academic certificates or latest results
- Proof of residence letter obtained from the relevant Ward Councillor of Amahlathi Local Municipality (*Residency of successful candidates will be verified by the Municipality*)
- Applicants must have completed their theoretical studies
- Availability to attend a compulsory interview (date to be communicated to shortlisted candidates)
- Minimum qualifications: 2 × N6 or national Diploma Civil Engineering, 2 × N6 or National Diploma Electrical Engineering & 2 × N5 or S4 Electrical Engineering.

Please note that **ONLY Students who are from the Amahlathi Locality will be considered as part of capacity and youth employment under this programme.**
